Die volgende rakende junior inskrywings het julle aandag nodig asseblief.

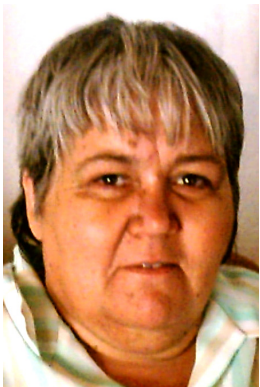

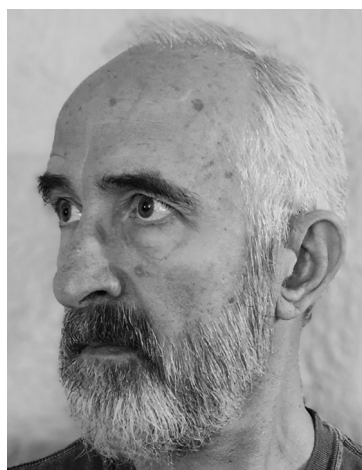

Duiwebeeldhouers

Ek het so stadigaan begin navorsing doen oor kunstenaars wereldwyd wat, soos ek, duiwebeelde maak of gemaak het. Ek probeer ook om van hulle werk in die hande te kry vir my versameling, Die reeks artikels gaan in Engels verskyn – vir ’n "Purebred Pigeon Figurine Special". Die eerste artikel oor my beeldjies het ek alreeds in die nuusbrieff geplaas. Hierdie tweede artikel is oor die Duitser Rudolf Lippmann.

Rudolf Lippmann – pigeon sculptor.



I first saw some of Lippmann’s work a few years ago on a visit to Gunter Weiher, in Ronneburg, Germany. Gunter is a breeder of excellent white Brunner Pouters. These were hand painted life size three-dimensional Brunner figurines in a variety of colours. I almost forgot about Lippmann, until recently, when I saw a solid brass hand painted Norwich Cropper statue (on Facebook) that was on auction in the USA some time ago. As the publisher of Purebred Pigeon magazine was approached by a friend in the USA to do a "Figurine Special" the idea to research Lippmann was born.



An AI search for Rudolf Lippmann (who made pigeon statues) was not fruitful. All AI could come up with was: *“Based on available records, there is no widely recognized artist or sculptor named “Rudolf Lippmann” associated with famous pigeon statues.”* I could however find the name amongst German Jews who

died in the Holocaust, but nothing about a sculptor by this name.

The Facebook photos of the Norwich Cropper showed that Rudolf Lippmann lived in the town of Oberhausen – HertastraSse 40, with the postal code 46117. The sticker on the wooden base of the Norwich statue looked very similar to that on the base of my Max Holdenreid statue. This placed Lippmann in the same era as Holdenreid. Armed with this information another AI search followed. The only information that came up when I asked about Lippmann living at HertastraSse 40, Oberhausen was a notice of his funeral, with the information that he was born on August 11, 1934, and passed away on February 27, 2010. Since the address on the statue matches that on the funeral notice, I knew I had a match, but this left me with no further knowledge. Where Lippmann spent the war, as a young boy with a Jewish surname, is not known to me. I have already asked about Lippmann on “The Moore Society” – a Facebook group for pigeon book collectors – of which a few members also collect figurines and statues. When this provided no answers, I ask the members of “Kropftaubenzuchter Europa” (another Facebook Group) for help.

My friend Manfred Loick sent me a copy of an article that appeared in the German small animal magazine Geflügel Zeitung Nr. 10/2010 – dated 21 May 2010. It reads as follows (direct translation with Google translate):

“Rudolf Lippmann

Our dear friend Rudolf Lippmann from Oberhausen-Osterfeld passed away unexpectedly on February 27th. Rudi would have turned 76 on August 11th. With him, a passionate pigeon breeder has left us forever.

In the 1950s, he came to the Ruhr area from Bavaria and was fascinated by the many pigeon lofts in the attics of houses. However, many years passed before he bought his first pair of pigeons. They were Brunner Pouters, black with white bars. He became a member of the Osterfeld-Heide Poultry and Pigeon Breeders Association (RGZV Osterfeld-Heide), which he led as chairman for a few years until the end. He also joined the Glück Auf Oberhausen Pigeon and Pigeon Breeders Association (RTZV Glück Auf Oberhausen), where he was a member for many years. In 1980, Rudi joined the Cypria Bottrop Pigeon and Pigeon Breeders Association (RTZV “Cypria”). As a specialist in colour inheritance in pigeons, Rudi was quickly elected breeding warden. Valuable lectures and tips were paramount in his work.

For his long-standing membership and activities in the Cypria Bottrop club, Rudi was made an honorary member.

As an active breeder of Brunner Pouter pigeons, Mr. Rudi Lippmann was also a member of the local club and was thus able to attend all special shows and present his birds, with which he won honorary and champion awards.

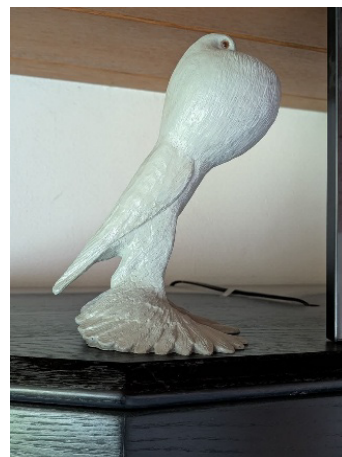
Rudi made a significant contribution to the development of several colour varieties, such as the Lavender (“silber”) variety. Due to his tireless dedication to the club — he donated his handcrafted pigeon figurines and wall plates to the club — Mr. Rudi was granted honorary membership and honoured with the gold badge of honour. With Mr. Rudolf Lippmann, we have lost a very dear and dedicated purebred poultry breeder. We must not forget

his wife, who always stood by his side in every situation. The members of the breeders’ associations mourn with her and her family.

KV Bottrop. Club of Brno Cropper Breeders, RTZV Cypria Bottrop”

The only other information I could find on Lippmann comes from the “Club der Brunner-Kropfer-Züchter 1910-2010” centenary booklet on p 68. *“Self-taught, he was himself a passionate breeder of the White-barred variety, and through his intensive study of the breed, he found his way to formal design. The application of various techniques ultimately led to very sophisticated objects.”*

Apart from the Brunner and Norwich statues, Rudi produced a Saxon Pouter, which he also painted as Reversewing, Hana and Bavarian statues, since these breeds are fairly similar in type, and mostly differ when it comes to markings. This information was provided to me by Reinhard Nawrotsky (owner of the white barred blue Brunner statue) and Martin Gangkofner (owner of the white Saxon Pouter), on the “Kropftaubenzüchter Europa” Facebook group. Based on photos taken in Lippmann’s workshop, he also made statues of Modenas as well as Kings.



Apart from the three shapes (six breeds) of Pouters, the only other statue that I am aware of at this stage is an Indian Runner Duck.

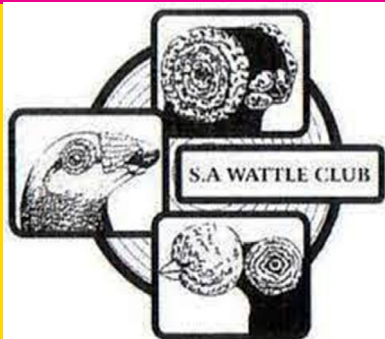
Martin’s involvement provides an interesting history of the Saxon Pouter statue. The commemo-

rate the 75 th anniversary of the Lower Bavarian District Association in 1997, Martin commissioned Lippmann to make these statues. Each judge had a (Bavarian) Cropper statue to award as the grand prize. The statues were made according to Martin's specifications. Back then, one still took photos, had them developed, and then sent them by mail in an

envelope. Rudolf Lippmann then made his blank (out of rubber) and sent photos of it back to Martin. This process went back and forth several times. So, Martin was the one who came up with the idea for this design at the time. He said that his contacts with Wolfgang Schreiber and the Brunner scene were helpful in this regard.
